WEED IDENTIFICATION

Ontario has had a ban on all traditional lawn weed control (herbicides) since April 2009. Over the past decade, many manufacturers researched alternatives but only one natural weed control has proven to be effective on most lawn weeds.

FIESTA Lawn Weed Killer (Reg. No. 29535 PCP Act) is a selective lawn bio-herbicide for professional applicators. It is derived from iron, which occurs in nature. It is odourless, rain-fast in 3 hours and works fast.

Fiesta works on many common lawn weeds but not all. To be clear, this chart will help in the identification of common lawn weeds. Crabgrass and weeds with small waxy leaves or woody roots are particularly resistant to Fiesta.

What to do to reduce the infestations of weeds: A healthy, thick turf will fend off most lawn weeds. Regular nutrition through fertilization, proper cultural habits (mowing and watering), and seeding annually with an Ottawa-blend grass seed are recommended.

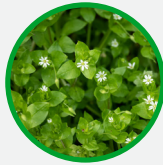

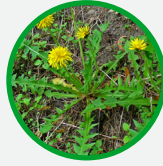

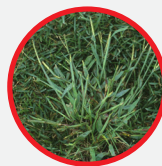
